I am directed to notify for information of all concerned that as directed by the Executive Council, the fees for Part-III Examinations of 2018 under the 1+1+1 system of Examination for the B.A./B. Sc./B. Com. Honors / General/ Major Degree Courses are given as follows. The fees are to be paid by each candidate at the time of filling up the Examination form at his/her college. Total fees are to be submitted by each college in form of a Demand Draft payable to 'West Bengal State University' within the stipulated date.

iii) Handling & Processing Fees : Rs.25/- (max. amount that may be charged by the College over & above the Exam Fees)



Annexure-IV

The amount of Centre fees received by Examination Centres for conducting Practical examinations is to be disbursed by the Centres in the following manner:

- 10% of the total amount received by the Centre towards Overhead expenses
- 50% towards cost of conducting Practical (samples, materials, apparatus etc.).
- 25% towards refreshment of the examiners and other personnel & college staff involved in the Practical
- 15% towards Contingency expenses and service charges

The above shall be applicable for the Undergraduate Examinations of 2018.
