GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR UNDER-GRADUATE SEMESTER-I EXAMINATIONS (HONS. AND GENERAL) TO BE HELD DURING THE PANDEMIC CAUSED ON ACCOUNT OF SARS-Cov-2

1. Students/ Examinees having valid Registration Numbers, Roll Numbers, and possessing Proper Admit Cards may write the examinations, sitting at home, in accordance with the programmes given on website.
2. Questions will be sent to the students through E-mail, or Whatsapp (WA), or any such mechanism that can be accessed.
3. Examinees may themselves or through their authorized representatives may collect question papers from the respective college offices.
4. Questions will be sent to students between 10.00 AM and 11.00 A.M. (there may be a little variation in time because of connectivity issues) on the dates of examinations or may be downloaded from the website www.wbsuexams.net by putting his/her registration number and students have to complete submission of written answer-scripts through E-mail by the same day/ date within 1 hr. For example, if the date of Examination is March 7, 2022; the papers must be submitted by March 7, 2022 by 2 pm.(1st half) and by 5 pm (2nd half). At the time of uploading answer-papers please submit a copy of the Admit Card also. (For Net work problem due to ongoing Madhyamik Examinations extra time has been given to the Students/Examinees). Colleges will be received the question papers at a time for both half due to network disturbance.
5. Any examinee having difficulty in uploading answer-script may send the written answer-script duly sealed in an envelope to the respective college office through authorized representative or S/he her/himself may submit the answer-script on the same day of the date of examination.
6. Students are strongly advised to write answers in their own words.
7. Students may write answers on University-approved answer-papers or they may write on A4 size papers.
8. Examinees must write their respective Registration Numbers and Roll Numbers on the top of each page. They are strongly advised to put page numbers as well.
9. Further advice in respect of examinations will be put on websites. Students are requested to go through the websites regularly.
