I am directed to notify for information of all concerned that the fees for Part-III Examinations of 2019 under the 1+1+1 system of Examination for the B.A./ B. Sc./B. Com./BBA Honors / General/ Major Degree Courses is given below. The fees are to be paid by each candidate at the time of filling in the Examination form. Total fees are to be submitted by the candidate through SBI Debit/Credit Card/ Net Banking, a receipt of which will be retained along with application form finally generated. Each college will verify the candidate's status as collegiate or non-collegiate before submitting the online application form and a verified list of the candidates will have to submit to West Bengal State University within stipulated date, given below:
